

Town Board Meeting – Tuesday, April 18, 2017

- Town Board Meeting was called to order by Chairman Bolz at 5:30 pm.
- Reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.
- Roll Call- Present were: Chairman Craig Bolz, Supervisor Ron Sromek, Treasurer Holly Sromek, Clerk Mary Quante, Grader Operator Pete Pernsteiner and Supervisor Bill Grote absent,.
- Chairman Bolz certified the meeting to be in compliance with the open/closed meetings law. Agenda was posted at the Grover Town Hall, Recycling Center and corner of Winter Sports Road.
- Motion to approve the April 18, 2017 agenda was made by Bolz, seconded by Sromek, all in favor, motion carried.
- Clerk Quante read the minutes from March 14, 2017. Motion to approve the minutes was made by Sromek, seconded by Bolz, all in favor, motion carried.
- Treasurer Sromek provided treasurers report for review. Motion made by Bolz to accept the report as written, seconded by Sromek, all in favor, motion carried.
- Approval of Expenses: Motion to approve town expenses was made by Bolz, seconded by Sromek, all in favor, motion carried.
- Board reviewed building permits – none submitted
- Discussion on ATV/UTV accidents in the Town of Grover – no issues
- Reviewed gravel and backhoe bids. Motion made by Bolz to accept gravel bid from James Peterson Sons, Pit Run \$7.50/cubic yard, 3”breaker run \$9.75/cubic yard, 5/8” gravel \$10.15/cubic yard, seconded by Sromek, all in favor, motion carried.
- Motion made by Sromek to accept the Backhoe/Dump Truck bid from Precision Dirtworks at \$110.00/hour for backhoe and \$80.00/hour for dump truck, seconded by Bolz, all in favor, motion carried.
- Discussion review truck bid publications. Item tabled to next meeting.

- Discuss grader chains. Item tabled to next meeting

- Motion made by Bolz to keep the rock rake, seconded by Sromek, all in favor, motion carried.

- Motion made by Bolz to allow James Peterson & Sons to park trailer on Town of Grover Town Hall property, seconded by Sromek, all in favor, motion carried.

- Comment: Chequamegon Wildlife & Recreation Club is donating a refrigerator and microwave to the Town Hall.

- Chairman Bolz will contact James Peterson & Sons regarding dust control on roads during construction. Resident requested temporary change of speed limit signs be posted so slow traffic especially dump trucks during construction season.
