

Town Board Meeting – Tuesday, June 9, 2015

- Town Board Meeting was called to order by Chairman Bolz at 7:00 p.m.
- Reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.
- Roll Call- Present were: Chairman Craig Bolz, Supervisor Bill Grote, Supervisor Ron Sromek, Treasurer Holly Sromek, Clerk Mary Quante and Grader Operator Pete Pernsteiner was absent.
- Chairman Bolz certified the meeting to be in compliance with the open/closed meetings law. Agenda was posted at the Grover Town Hall, Recycling Center and corner of Winter Sports Road.
- Motion to approve the June 9, 2015 agenda was made by Bolz, seconded by Grote , motion carried.
- Clerk Quante read the minutes from May 12, 2015. Motion to approve the minutes was made by Bolz, seconded by Sromek, motion carried.
- Treasurer Sromek provided treasurers report for review. Motion made by Bolz to accept the report as written, seconded by Grote, motion carried.
- Approval of Expenses: Motion to approve town expenses was made by Grote, seconded by Sromek, motion carried.
- Board reviewed building permits. None submitted.
- Board discussed delivery dates for dust control. Dust control is scheduled for the week of June 15th.
- Board reviewed liquor licenses. Motion made by Bolz to approve liquor licenses for Rock Point Bait Shop and Perkinstown Saloon and Grill, seconded by Sromek, motion carried.
- Board reviewed ad for publication of town items for sale. Motion made by Bolz to run publication one week in local paper, seconded by Grote, motion carried.

- Tim Vetter with the Forest Service could not be present at the meeting but forwarded information to the clerk regarding the pavilion repairs. This information was passed on to Ron Sromek and he is following up on having the pavilion repaired according to specs required by the Forest Service. The Chequamegon Wildlife Club is paying for the repairs to pavilion.

- Discussion on options for the old town hall and jail were discussed. Clerk will be contacting the Taylor County Historic Society to see if they would be interested in the taking the record books. Repairs on the jail roof were tabled to next month.

- Future agenda items: town siren, Lake Kathryn Campground and boating landing update, old town hall and jail, review bids for town hall items

- Motion to adjourn made by Grote, seconded by Sromek, motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:03 p.m.
