

Town Board Meeting – Tuesday, September 12, 2017

- Town Board Meeting was called to order by Chairman Bolz at 5:30 pm.
- Reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.
- Roll Call- Present were: Chairman Craig Bolz, Supervisor Ron Sromek, Supervisor Bill Grote, Treasurer Holly Sromek, Clerk Mary Quante and Grader Operator Pete Pernsteiner.
- Chairman Bolz certified the meeting to be in compliance with the open/closed meetings law. Agenda was posted at the Grover Town Hall, Recycling Center and corner of Winter Sports Road.
- Motion to approve the September 12, 2017 agenda was made by Bolz, seconded by Sromek, all in favor, motion carried.

- Treasurer Sromek provided treasurers report for review. Motion made by Sromek to accept the report as written, seconded by Bolz, all in favor, motion carried.
- Approval of Expenses: Motion to approve town expenses was made by Sromek, seconded by Bolz, all in favor, motion carried.
- Board reviewed building permits. Motion made to approve Tonia Sromek and Tom Duell building permits by Sromek contingent upon zoning approval, seconded by Grote, all in favor, motion carried.
- Discussion on ATV/UTV accidents in the Town of Grover – None
- Discussion reviewed truck bid publications. Motion made by Grote to run ad in local paper two times with a starting bid of \$20,000 to sell town truck, seconded by Sromek, all in favor, motion carried.

- Discussion on brush mower attachment. Tabled to next month.
- Discussion on road right of way purchase. Motion made by Bolz to not sell Brush Creek Road right of way at this time, seconded by Grote, all in favor, motion carried.
- Future agenda items: Town Truck bids, brush mower, preliminary budget
- Motion to adjourn made by Sromek, seconded by Grote, all in favor, motion carried.
