- Town Board Meeting was called to order by Chairman Bolz at 7:00 pm.
- Reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

- Discussion on trucking road ordinance for bend project and discussion on zoning ordinance. Board reviewed ordinance and tabled to next month meeting.
- Discussion on 4-H building and property. Lucky Hills 4-H group dissolved now the property reverts back to town to be used for community purpose. The clerk will contact Gilman School district administration and discuss the town boards interest in retaining the property for future community use. Tabled to next month meeting.
