

## Town Board Meeting – Tuesday, July 14, 2020

- Town Board Meeting was called to order by Chairman Bolz at 6:03 pm
- Reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.
- Roll Call- Present were: Chairman Craig Bolz, Supervisor, Bill Grote, Supervisor Dane Bolz, Town Clerk Mary Quante, Treasurer Emily Quante and Grader Operator Joe Zenner.
- Chairman Bolz certified the meeting to be in compliance with the open/closed meetings law. Agenda was posted at the Grover Town Hall, Recycling Center and corner of Winter Sports Road.
- Motion to approve the current agenda was made by Craig Bolz, seconded by Grote, all in favor, motion carried.
- Motion to approve the minutes from last month was made by Grote, seconded by Dane Bolz, all in favor, motion carried.
- Treasurers report was provided.
- Approval of Expenses: Motion to approve town expenses was made by Dane Bolz, seconded by Grote, all in favor, motion carried.
- Board reviewed building permits, certified survey maps and operator's licenses. Motion made by Dane Bolz to approve Bartnik building permit, seconded by Grote, all in favor, motion carried.
- Discussion on ATV/UTV accidents in the Town of Grover. None
- Discussion on 4-H building and property. Lucky Hills 4-H group dissolved now the property reverts back to town to be used for community purpose. Board reviewed warranty deed. Dane Bolz made a motion to accept warranty deed and addendum/Exhibit A dated June 29, 2020 from Taylor County Register of Deeds, seconded by Grote all in favor, motion carried.  
Dane Bolz made a motion to appoint residents of Town of Grover to a Committee Group that will advise Town Board of future ideas/plans for the building and property, seconded by Grote, all in favor, motion carried.

- Discussion on grader attachment. Board members will look at actual working attachment to learn more about what it can do.
- Discussion on grader grant process. Tabled to next month.
- Discussion on 90 day employee review for full-time maintenance operator Joe Zenner. Discussion on possible retirement plan. Board reviewed last 3-months of employee work performance. Motion made Dane Bolz to increase the hourly wage by \$1.50 per hour and of that amount \$1.00 is pre-tax with the town matching it with \$1.00 and deposit to retirement account, seconded by Grote, all in favor, motion carried. Next employee 6-month review December 2020.

- Motion to adjourn made by Grote, seconded by seconded by Dane Bolz, all in favor, motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:14 pm.
